- 1. Introduction, agenda review, and meeting approval** - Members introduced themselves and approved the March 2016 meeting summary. The one change to the agenda was exchange the order of the fish passage database presentation to the place of Shore Friendly presentation.
- 2. Fish Passage Dbase** - Brittany showed participants the WDFW fish passage data base. The state has PIs for all WSDOT culverts and for some non-WSDOT culverts. The database is available for use online and shows species presence and blockages.
- 3. Shore Friendly presentation** – Kathlene Barnhart with Kitsap County highlighted the Shore Friendly program. Shoreline armoring is a vital sign in the Puget Sound Action Agenda. She reported that 48% of county’s residential parcels are armored (out of 7, 8000 – 4,700 are armored). The goal is to have at least five bulkhead removal projects. This presentation will be posted on the WSWC website. A site tour, mostly for shoreline property owners, will be held on August 2 at 6:30 pm. The tour will leave from Suquamish. It is anticipated that 250 will attend. You can sign up at the Shore Friendly website.
- 4. Puget Sound Partnership Update** – Amber could not attend but provided the group with a written update. Please see attached document for PSP update provided by Amber Moore.
- 5. Four year work plan discussion** – Plan submitted to Puget Sound Partnership for project sponsors to edit their projects in Smartsheet. The plan is due on March 31, 2016. The Four year work plan narrative is in draft form and is available for review. The TAG went over the document in detail on May 10 and made first round edits. It will be reviewed over the summer and there will be many future opportunities for people to weigh in. Marian offered to send it out to CAG members for review. No one asked for it.
- 6. 2016 Grant round update** – Marian provided the latest on 2016 projects. Some sponsors removed their projects or made minor edits.
- 7. Information Sharing** – **WDFW** – Participated in Kitsap County’s Comprehensive Plan. They will be participating in Kitsap County’s Critical Areas Ordinance. The Gorst restoration landfill project is breaking ground soon. **Senator Rolfes’ Office** – Nothing to report. **WSU** – Renee J. has 20 site visits with volunteers for Shore Friendly program and 30 new volunteers for beach naturalists. **Enetai** – Glen reported that he is finishing up his project proposal in PRISM. **Key Pen. Metro Park**

District –Gateway Park ground breaking event on July 4. **DOE** – Nothing to report. **Mid Sound Fisheries Enhancement Group** – The group is combining 4 nearshore projects. They removed Dog Fish Creek, Carpenter Creek, two Cowling Creek projects and chose not to sponsor Enetai Creek. **GPC** – Welcome to Johnathan Decker, newly hired at GPC, grew up in Seattle and his last job was at Vermont land trust. **KCPW** Renee S. has three big projects 1) Phase 2 Dickerson Creek, 2) Clear Creek floodplain restoration, 3) Treatment wetland to filter 18 acres of stormwater behind Car Toys (Off Chico Creek). **City of Bremerton** – Doing 2 bridges on forest lands in Gorst watershed. MSFEG offered to work with City on projects. **Kitsap County DCD** – Comprehensive plan update is wrapping up and critical Area Ordinance working group will start soon. Kathlene asked to be put on future fall agenda to update the CAG.
