The West Sound Watersheds PSAR/SRFB allocation is predicted to be \$1,388,404\*. Dark line represents approximate funding line. (Projects below will be approved as alternates).

The Technical Advisory Group recommends sponsor for the last two projects continue with the application process, to be approved as alternates. Alternate projects are funded with no additional review if funding is made available through return funds or other circumstances.

\*We will also be receiving grants for two "large capital projects" if the legislature approves the PSAR funding at the level expected at this time. Those projects are "Milwaukee Dock Eelgrass Restoration Project" (\$1,802,000) and "West Bainbridge Shoreline Protection" (\$810,000), which were approved by WSWC and the Puget Sound Salmon Recovery Council in 2012.
